Individual (Individual Junior) Competition Rules

Access to the individual Open Final is gained through the following two qualification runs:

Friday – Jumping Open qualification run

Saturday - Agility Open qualification run.

The qualification runs will be splitted on two rings; one ring for categories Small/Medium and the second ring for categories Intermedium/Large.

In each qualification run the following teams will enter the Final:

- Small/Medium/Intermedium 7 teams each category
- Large 11 teams.

The Final will thus have:

- Small 14 teams
- Medium 14 teams
- Intermedium 14 teams
- Large 22 teams.

The Junior Final (identical final run to the individual Final) qualification will consist of 2 teams each category Small, Medium, Intermedium and Large. Access will be gained equally through the two Open qualification runs on Friday and Saturday.

In case a Junior team should qualify for the Individual Final, this will not give the right to not Junior teams ranked after them to move forward to the Final.

The Open Junior Final will contain:

- Small 4 teams
- Medium 4 teams
- Intermedium 4 teams
- Large 4 teams.

The teams which will qualify through the Open run on Friday, in case they will also qualify on Saturday, will move forward the next ranked team of the Saturday qualification.

The Open Final will consist of a sole Agility run. The qualified teams must mandatory be registered to the Sunday's ENCI competition. For anything not clearly mentioned please refer to the ENCI regulation.

The Final runs will be different for categories Small/Medium and Intermedium/Large.

Team Competition Rules:

This year we have decided to introduce a Team Final which will be run on Sunday afternoon. This Final will consist of a sole Jumping run in relay mode. The total time will be measured from the 1st handler departing until the 3rd handler finishing with their dogs. In case one of the handlers should be eliminated the run should be equally finished and 100 penalty points will be assigned. In case the eliminated handler should not finish the course and exits the ring, the entire team will be disqualified regardless of the results of the other two handlers.

The Team Final will allow the first 5 ranked Teams which will totalize the best score in each category (Small/Medium/Intermedium/Large). Each Team will consist of 3 handlers with dogs of identical category, whereas the dogs levels may differ (degree 1, 2 or 3).

The Teams will totalize scores at the ENCI competitions on Friday and Saturday, where both the results in Agility and Jumping runs will be taken into account.

In case of equal merit between the 5th and 6th classified Teams or beyond, these Teams will all enter the Final on Sunday.

The score will be counted as follows:

- 1st Classified 15 points multiplied by the number of participants to the run
- 2nd Classified 12 points multiplied by the number of participants to the run
- 3rd Classified 10 points multiplied by the number of participants to the run
- 4th Classified 8 points multiplied by the number of partecipants to the run
- 5th Classified 6 points multiplied by the number of partecipants to the run
- 6th Classified 5 points multiplied by the number of partecipants to the run
- 7th Classified 4 points multiplied by the number of partecipants to the run
- 8th Classified 3 points multiplied by the number of partecipants to the run
- 9th Classified 2 points multiplied by the number of partecipants to the run
- 10th Classified 1 point multiplied by the number of participants to the run.

Example:

A Team composed of 3 Medium dog handlers, handler A 1st degree, handler B 2nd degree, handler C 3rd degree.

Agility (or Jumping) 1st degree Medium – 30 participants

Agility (or Jumping) 2nd degree Medium – 40 participants

Agility (or Jumping) 3rd degree Medium – 25 participants.

Results of the single Team members:

Handler A ranked 5th in 1st degree = 6 points x 30 participants = 180 points

Handler B ranked 7^{th} in 2^{nd} degree = 4 points x 40 participants = 160 points

Handler C ranked 1st in 3rd degree = 15 points x 25 participants = 375 points.

The Team will have a total run score of 715 points. To this score the points of the remaining 3 runs will be added.
