



# ALPINE AGILITY OPEN

The competition will have a limited number of places admitting maximum 340 binomials of which 28 binomials reserved for Juniors making part of the national Enci team.

Registration for the competition must be made on website page

within 4-5 working days you will be notified with the bank details for payment. Once the payment is received registration of the binomial will be confirmed by e-mail. We remind you that each competitor needs to be recorded on the webportal sport.enci.it, so must each single dog *and* each competing binomial (handler+dog). The competition entries will follow date and time of registration, with preference for those who will register for the 3 days of competition.

In case the registrations should exceed the maximum number of places, a public waiting list will be originated.

Any registered binomial, in case of inability/impossibility either voluntary or unpredicted to attend the competition will thus be able to contact and to transfer the competition spot to somebody on the waiting list.

Any competition spot transfer must be duly notified to the organizing committee at e-mail address [info@alpineagilityopen.it](mailto:info@alpineagilityopen.it).

The competitor who transfers his spot and the beneficiary of the same will settle the registration fee between them. Deadline for spot transfers and notifications Wednesday June 5, 2024.

Possible withdrawals starting from Thursday June 6, 2024 will only be accepted against presentation of a **veterinary medical report**. In such case, and no other, the registration fee will be reimbursed deducting € 5,00 (Euro five) administrative fees for each competition day.

Registrations will open on Thursday April 18, 2024 at 20:00 pm.

## Individual Open

Possibility to enter the individual Open Final on Sunday afternoon through 2 qualification rounds:

- Friday qualification round Open Agility
- Saturday qualification round Open Jumping

The Open qualification rounds will be run on two different rings: one for categories Small/Medium/Intermedium and the other one for category Large.

In each Open qualification the following binomials may gain access to the Final:

- the first 6 binomials of each of the categories Small/Medium/Intermedium
- the first 15 binomials of the category Large
- the winners of the Open Juniors of the categories Small/Medium/intermedium and Large.

La Individual Open Final will be composed of:

- 13 binomials category Small
- 13 binomials category Medium
- 13 binomials category Intermedium
- 31 binomials category Large.

The Open Final spot of those binomials which will qualify for the Final after the Open qualification round on Friday, in case they should also be qualified on Saturday, will move to the next binomial in the ranking of the Saturdays Open qualification round.

The Individual Open Final on Sunday will consist of a single Agility run. Only qualified binomials which are registered for the **Sundays ENCI competition** are allowed to participate to the Final. For any rules not herein mentioned please refer to the ENCI regulation.

The Individual Final Open runs will be different for categories Small/Medium and Intermedium/Large.

## **Open Juniors for handlers less than 18 years old**

A novelty of the 2024 edition will be an Open competition on Saturday afternoon reserved to handlers less than 18 years old. At the registration procedure either just the Open Juniors competition can be marked or both the Enci competition plus the Open Juniors.

In case of competition limited to the Open Juniors the competition fee will be € 10,00 (Euro ten).

The Open Juniors competition will have a semifinal and a final both on Saturday afternoon. The Junior handlers will first run an Agility semifinal identical for all categories Small/Medium/Intermedium and Large.

The first 5 binominals of each category will access the Open Juniors Final on Saturday afternoon.

The winner of each category of the Open Juniors Final will be qualified for the Individual Open Final on Sunday.

### **Teams:**

Also this year we will repeat the Teams Final which will be held on Sunday afternoon. There will be a sole Agility course with a specular run to be faced in relay mode.

Part of the run will contain the obstacles for the Small or Intermedium, the specular part will have the obstacles for Medium or Large.

The total time will sum the start of the 1st dog until the finish of the 3rd dog. In case of elimination the run has to be finished and 100 penalty points will be assigned. In case the run will not be finished the entire team will be disqualified independently of the remaining two results.

The Teams Final will admit the first 7 classified teams of the categories Small/Medium and the first 10 classified teams Intermedium/Large. The teams will consist of 3 binominals belonging to Small/Medium categories or 3 binominals belonging to Intermedium/Large categories. Each team may contain dogs of different degrees.

Each team member can gain points during the individual ENCI competitions (not including the Open qualification runs) on Friday and Saturday, both results in agility and jumping will be taken into account.

In case of equal result of the 5th and 6th team or beyond, all these access the Final.

The following points will be assigned::

- 1st 15 points multiplied per total number of competitors in the ENCI run
- 2nd 12 points multiplied per total number of competitors in the ENCI run
- 3rd 10 points multiplied per total number of competitors in the ENCI run
- 4th 8 points multiplied per total number of competitors in the ENCI run
- 5th 6 points multiplied per total number of competitors in the ENCI run
- 6th 5 points multiplied per total number of competitors in the ENCI run
- 7th 4 points multiplied per total number of competitors in the ENCI run
- 8th 3 points multiplied per total number of competitors in the ENCI run
- 9th 2 points multiplied per total number of competitors in the ENCI run
- 10th 1 point multiplied per total number of competitors in the ENCI run

For instance:

A team of 3 binominals competing in Medium category: A in 1st degree, B in 2nd degree and C in 3rd degree:

Agility (or jumping) 1st degree - Medium - 30 participants  
Agility (or jumping) 2nd degree - Medium - 40 participants  
Agility (or jumping) 3rd degree - Medium- 25 participants

Results of the team members:

- A - classified 5th in 1st degree: 6 points x 30 participants = 180 points
- B - classified 7th in 2nd degree: 4 points x 40 participants = 160 points
- C - classified 1st in 3rd degree: 15 points x 25 participants = 375 points

In this run the team has totalized 715 points. The grand total will sum the totalized points of the remaining 3 runs.
